

**Directions to the Austin State Hospital Chapel** 

IMPORTANT: The <u>Guadalupe Street entrance is CLOSED</u>. A new State hospital building is being built on the Austin State Hospital grounds.

The ONLY ENTRANCE is on the South side of **45<sup>th</sup> Street** between Guadalupe and Lamar <u>Streets with a sign marked "Turner Construction Entrance #1</u>." There is no sign marking it as the entrance to Austin State Hospital.

Enter the 45<sup>th</sup> Street construction entrance with your mask on, and stop to answer the Security Guard's questions. Tell them you are with Wednesday Morning Music Club. <u>Continue</u> <u>straight</u> to the fence at the end, also marked with the words "Turner," where you make <u>a left</u> <u>turn</u> and then an <u>IMMEDIATE RIGHT</u> and <u>another quick left</u> turn. <u>Stop! You are here!</u> The Chapel is the building to your right. Park in the large parking lot that contains construction workers' trucks and cars. The Chapel is marked "All Saints Chapel," has a colorful, painted mural of a tree, and is marked Building 639.
