

2025 Wilcox, Maurer, Putter and Rudd Music Awards for High School Students
Music Club Austin - TFMC, NFMC
(formerly Wednesday Morning Music Club)

Purpose: Music Club Austin Awards for High School Students are intended to encourage and reward a high degree of performance excellence and to assist students with their musical education.

Eligibility: Any student whose parents are legal residents of the City of Austin, Travis County, Leander ISD, Round Rock ISD, or Dripping Springs ISD shall be eligible to compete for these awards. Students in 9th, 10th and 11th grades are eligible to compete for the Wilcox awards, with the exception of former first-place winners. Students who are 12th grade graduating seniors are eligible to compete for the Maurer and Putter awards.

Award Amounts: Maurer Award for First Place Senior: **\$3000**
Putter Award for Second Place Senior: **\$2800**
Wilcox Awards: First Place **\$2600**, Second Place **\$2400**
Sally Strawn Rudd Supplemental Award: **\$250** at the discretion of the judges.

Repertoire: All contestants must perform three **memorized** solo selections in contrasting styles.

Instrumentalists' selections must represent three different historical style periods of music.

Vocalists must perform one selection from each of the following categories:

- 1) An art song in the original language
- 2) A sacred song, not a hymn
- 3) An Italian song or aria sung in Italian

Performance:

- 1) Auditions will be limited to **twelve minutes total**. The time **between** pieces is counted in the twelve-minute period. Mark clearly any necessary cuts.
- 2) Please provide one set of your contest music for the judges. Soloists with accompanists need supply only the solo part. **Use of photocopied music will disqualify the contestant.** Please read the rules regarding photocopies on page three of this document.
- 3) Contestants who need an accompanist must provide their own.

Time and Place: Saturday, **March 22, 2025**, 10:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M., at **Steinway Piano Gallery**, 12980 Research Blvd., Austin. Contestants must arrive **15 minutes** before their assigned times and must agree to perform earlier than scheduled, if required by the committee. The current COVID protocols will be observed.

Result Notification: The winners will be announced at the end of each contest. First and second place winners must perform for Music Club Austin on **Wednesday, May 14, 2025**, at 11:00 a.m. in order to receive their awards. All participants will receive email notification of the results by the end of the day. The judges' comment sheets will be mailed to all participants within two weeks after the contest.

If an original of the music to be played is not provided for the judge, the contestant WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY.

POLICY CONCERNING USE OF DIGITALLY DOWNLOADED SHEET MUSIC

In the current technological age, purchasing and using hard copies of sheet music is no longer the only option for teachers and students. Much repertoire is now legitimately available online, either from sites that charge fees for downloads, or those that provide free copies of music that is in the public domain.

In recognition of this resource, copies of scores that have been downloaded from the Internet will be accepted for use at the Wilcox and Maurer contests. Because such scores may be difficult to distinguish from illegal photocopies, the contestant must bring proof that a score is downloaded, and be prepared to show such proof to the chair of the Wilcox and Maurer contests. Proof that music is downloaded and not photocopied can be provided in several ways, including but not limited to:

1. A printed receipt or other proof of purchase.
2. A URL address where the score was downloaded. Some sites will automatically print this on a downloaded score.
3. A printed URL at the bottom of the copy provided, added by the computer from which the music was printed.

Contestants who do not provide sufficient proof that sheet music has been downloaded and not illegally photocopied will not be permitted to perform. It may be noted that editions of standard repertoire from free download sites vary widely in accuracy and completeness. Contestants are advised to use standard editions whenever feasible. Multiple sheets should be taped, stapled or placed in a binder so that the judges looking at scores do not have to deal with loose paper.
